### CALL FOR PAPERS

The INDCP publishes an annual newsletter in which international experiences are presented either with the MDH-PPH model and its instruments (MHAVIE, MQE, etc.) or with the promotion of the rights of people who experience situations where their social participation is restricted on an equal footing with other members of their community.

This newsletter available in PDF is distributed free of charge by email to our networks of accredited and institutional instructors as well as our partners which include the Belgian, French, Swiss and Algerian networks on the DCP. This newsletter has the modest goal of sharing experiences to promote exchanges between our networks. As such, it differs from the *Aequitas* journal which aims at experienced researchers and whose editorial charter guarantees a high quality of content: [Aequitas – Érudit \(erudit.org\)](http://erudit.org).

#### **Proposal Selection Criteria**

##### **1. Theme**

The proposal must address a topic related to:

- a. An experience in the application of the HDM-DCP and/or its instruments (LIFE-H, MQE, etc.) whether in the context of training, health, education, the development of an inclusive collective environment, etc.
- b. An experience promoting the rights of people with disabilities particularly in relation to the rights and values of the CRPD (UN, 2006).

##### **2. Format**

- a. Word count: 350 words maximum in Arial, font size 11, Word format, 1.5 line spacing in A4 format and 2.5 cm top/bottom, left/right margins.
- b. Language: French or English.
- c. Illustration: A maximum of one photo in jpg format with a minimum width of 400 pixels and a resolution of 72 dpi.
- d. Acknowledgments: The identity of the author(s) must be specified as well as their main occupation and affiliation with an organization.
- e. Bibliographic references: Only if cited in the text. They are listed at the end of the text in the following format:

- i. Book: Author, A. A. (Year of publication). *Title of work* (edition, volume).  
Publisher Name. DOI or URL
- ii. Web Page: Author, A. A. (Year, Month Date). *Title of page*. Site name.

### 3. Ethics

- a. The proposal may have already been published. In this case, the contact details of the publication must be mentioned as well as the publisher's agreement.
- b. The proposal must respect the values set out in Article 3 of the CRPD:
  - I. *Respect for inherent dignity, individual autonomy including the freedom to make one's own choices, and independence of persons;*
  - II. *Non-discrimination;*
  - III. *Full and effective participation and inclusion in society;*
  - IV. *Respect for difference and acceptance of persons with disabilities as part of human diversity and humanity;*
  - V. *Equality of opportunity;*
  - VI. *Accessibility;*
  - VII. *Equality between men and women;*
  - VIII. *Respect for the evolving capacities of children with disabilities and respect for the right of children with disabilities to preserve their identities.*
- c. The proposal cannot be submitted with the intention to promote a commercial activity.
- d. The use of artificial intelligence in the drafting of the text must be clearly indicated in your proposal.
- e. The proposal cannot promote a dogmatic approach based for example on religious arguments or unsubstantiated claims.

### 4. Selection Process

Proposals will be reviewed independently by the INDCP's International Committee.

### Schedule

1. **Submission deadline:** no later than November 18, 2024
2. **Proposal acceptance confirmation:** December 16, 2024
3. **Newsletter distribution date:** January 15, 2025
